This Latino gun opera is a fastpaced flick that turns up the heat south of the border, courtesy of Antonio Banderas and Salma Hayek. In a breakthrough role, Salma plays a curvacious bookstore owner who helps a musicianturned-killing-machine avenge his lover's murder. In between the bloody showdowns, the pace slows to let us relish the sensuous love scenes. At one point, while doing it in a candlelit room, Antonio takes the spurs from his boots and runs them slowly down the length of Salma's salsa-hot body. Sure, there are Spanish subtitles, but all the fiery action needs no translation.

#### 7. Mulholland Drive

Like most David Lynch movies, fuggedabout trying to make sense of it. Just keep your eyes on the prize... a.k.a. the two women who get it on as lesbian lovers. Naomi Watts plays a blonde with small-town, gee-whiz enthusiasm for stardom, and Laura Harring is her smokin' hot amnesiac houseguest. Early on, their touching and make-out sessions are like an innocent sexual experiment. But as the plot thickens, there's more moaning between the sheets and their electrifying passion turns obsessive.

In this offbeat indie hit, the boss-secretary relationship crosses lines of conduct that would send HR into a hissy-fit. But for Maggie Gyllenhaal as a self-harming wallflower, a severe spanking does more than boost productivity. She's a secretary who spends her days 'bonding' with her boss - played by a strung-out yet subdued James Spader. When they finally admit their feelings aloud, he's bathed her in his tub and boned her on a grass-covered bed. From her blatantly erotic upward gazes, to his controlled tone in demanding she assume the position, their S&M deviancy shows how anyone can get, and give, what they want.
